



Infection protection in the control room simulator

The Robert Koch Institute (RKI) and the German Federal Center for health education (BZgA) recommend preventive hygiene and behavioral measures to protect against SARS-CoV-2. Against this background, we have adapted the concept of our meetings accordingly.



Limited number of participants: At the meetings in the control room simulator maximum of **ten** persons take part, plus JST consultants. For the JST Academy there is an upper limit of **six** participants.



No handshakes: We do without this greeting ritual and give each other a smile.



Prevention: For your and our protection we ask you not to invite any employees with symptoms of a cold.



Consistent separation: The control room simulator has both a separate entrance and separate washrooms that are exclusively available to your team.



Room disinfection: All surfaces in the control room simulator are carefully disinfected before and after meetings. This also applies to keyboards and mice.





Hand disinfection: In the control room simulator there are disinfection dispensers ready for you. Please use these before the start of the event and during the meeting, for example after each using of the simulator equipment. Alternatively, the washrooms are available for manual hand cleaning.



Spacing rules: Both at the conference table and during the practical parts on the technical equipment of the control room simulator, 1.5 meters is the minimum distance between participants.



Face mask: During the practical sessions, all participants wear a face mask. We will have this available for you. At the conference table, wearing it is optional, taking into account the distance rules.



Rules of behavior: Each visitor will use only his or her assigned seat at the conference table. No work materials such as documents, pens, etc. are exchanged between participants during the meeting.



Caterings: We provide small, closed beverage bottles for all guests. The use of glasses is waived. The consumption of food is currently not possible in the control room simulator.



Lunch break: During a 45-minute break, participants have the opportunity to eat individually in the immediate vicinity. We will be happy to inform you about the nearest options. During the break, the control room simulator will be intensively ventilated.



Result: The results of the workshop are transmitted to you exclusively digitally.
